

UNIVERSITY COURSES

University courses are those courses taught at the University of Idaho, New St. Andrews College, Lewis & Clark State College, Washington State University and Walla Walla Community College.

Procedures

1. Before registering for a university course, the student should contact the principal requesting approval to enroll.
2. Approval will usually be granted for academic courses. Approval for recreational, physical education, or business courses will probably be denied.
3. If necessary, students may be dismissed five minutes early from a Logos School class in order to have time to get to a university course on time.
4. Students will receive one-half of the college credits earned for the course toward Logos High School graduation requirements.
5. The grade for this course will be that which the student receives from the university. This grade will be recorded on the student's transcript but will not be factored into the student's cumulative grade point average.
